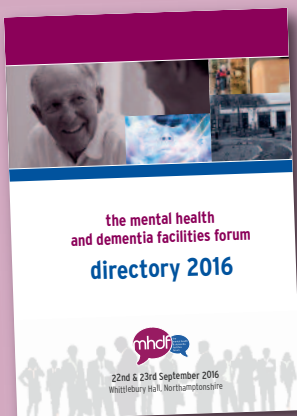

- More than £4.5bn will be spent enhancing mental health and dementia facilities across the UK over the next five years.
- Currently there are more than 230 construction projects that include an element of mental health, dementia, or other specialist provision, either in progress or awaiting planning approval. Collectively, these projects are worth more than £3bn. In particular, around £300m is being invested in secure mental health units.
- There are also over 90 dementia construction projects in the pipeline, worth more than £1.5bn to the industry. And this figure is expected to increase significantly over the next three years as more emphasis is placed on community-based dementia care and private sector investment increases rapidly.
